Worship Planning Notes

- Be sure to include the theme of financial literacy and/or some of the following key words: *Financial literacy lessens poverty and is part of showing God that we are faithful stewards*. Also be mindful of the Scripture lessons: Proverbs 14:23 and Proverbs 28:20.
- This service can be coupled with or be the culminating service for church-wide financial planning seminars. Have intergenerational discussions about living within your means, tithing, and saving. Brief testimonies of successful financial turn-arounds in your congregation can be shared during the service.
- During the altar call, the pastor or another minister can cut up paid off credit cards, shred paid off bills, etc.
